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### *An Active in Mission Update*

Hello everyone. The last time Laura Lee & I wrote to you, we were preparing to “get active” once again as part of CBM’s annual *Active in Mission* (AiM) campaign. We thought it was time to give you an update.

**The Mission:** Every day, around the world, a significant percentage of people go hungry. The causes are many: economic downturns, wars and violence, mental health issues, old patterns and habits, extreme weather, etc. The problem is so massive, we can be tempted to throw up our hands in despair, paralyzed by discouragement and hopelessness. However, there is another option. Even if we can’t “solve” the whole problem, we can become **Active** in doing our part to make a difference in the lives of some of those people. That is why CBM is joining hands with our Baptist denominational partners across the country (CBWC, CBOQ, UÉBFC, CBAC), encouraging people to get **Active** in order to increase awareness and to raise money to battle food insecurity in Canada as well as 13 other countries around the world. The goal is \$100,000.

But on August 4, we completed our final outing, reaching the 20.29 km mark ... thankfully just a few days before the woods were closed due to fire risk.
